## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, I, Phil Bryant, Governor of the State of Mississippi, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the Constitution of the State of Mississippi and Miss. Code Ann. §33-15-11(b)(17) and in the public interest and for the general welfare, previously proclaimed a State of Emergency for certain areas of the State on December 30, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the proclamation of December 30, 2015, concerned flooding as a result of rising waters due to rain in the upper Mississippi River Basin and Ohio River Basin that no longer threaten public safety as prescribed in Section 33-15-11(b)(17):

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I Phil Bryant, Governor of the State of Mississippi, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the Constitution of the State of Mississippi and Miss. Code Ann. §33-15-11(b)(17), do hereby issue this Proclamation to declare that the State of Emergency pronounced on December 30, 2015, no longer exists and is hereby terminated.
