Executive Order 1379

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2016, President Barack Obama issued a Proclamation ordering the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff on all public buildings and grounds until sunset June 16, 2016, in respect for the victims of hatred and terror perpetrated on Sunday, June 12, 2016, in Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the prayers of the people of this State are with the victims and their families:

NOW THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction immediately until sunset on Thursday, June 16, 2016.
